As we close out 2024, we celebrate another incredible year of growth, innovation, and community at the Newtown Public Library. This year, we proudly unveiled our bright and fun new logo, reflecting the energy and vibrancy of our library. We also marked our 50th anniversary, a milestone that reaffirmed our commitment to fostering the joy of reading and lifelong learning.

Our Summer Reading Program was a season of adventure, bringing families together through unforgettable events like the Glow Party, Family Fort Night, Water Day, Disco Dance Party, and Amazing Learners Series. We also gathered as a community to watch the eclipse—clouds and all! Beyond summer, our year—round children's programs continued to thrive, sparking curiosity and discovery.

For adults, we expanded our offerings, introducing engaging author visits and the lively P.U.B. Quizzo, while our French conversation group doubled its meetings, and weekly yoga replaced our monthly sessions. Thanks to a grant from the PA Department of Community and Economic Development and support from the Friends of the Library, we also opened a new meeting space, creating more opportunities for learning and connection. In addition, the Friends of the Library helped us enhance our outdoor patio space, providing a more inviting area for reading, gathering, and enjoying the library in a fresh new way.

Meanwhile, our circulation of physical and electronic materials soared to nearly 175,000 checkouts, reflecting the ever-growing love of reading in our community.

None of this would be possible without the unwavering support of our patrons, the Friends of the Library, our Board of Trustees, the Newtown Township staff and Board of Supervisors, and especially PA Rep. Lisa Borowski and her staff for their continued support of our library. 3 public computers were used 1,683 times




